

CSBio Graduate Research Grant

Overview

The CSBio Graduate Research Grant is a quarterly funding opportunity offered by CSBio Instrumentation, designed to support graduate students and postdoctoral researchers working in peptide-focused laboratories. With a quarterly commitment of \$2,000, this grant aims to alleviate out-of-pocket expenses that peptide researchers may incur outside of typical lab or PI-funded budgets.

Who Can Apply

Graduate students and postdoctoral researchers who are actively engaged in peptide research and currently working in an academic or institutional lab are eligible to apply.

What the Grant Covers

Graduate students and postdoctoral researchers can apply for reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses for peptide related activities not covered by the applicant's lab or principal investigator. Eligible expenses include a wide range of academic and professional fees, such as:

- Conference travel and registration fees
- Lab supplies or materials (especially for specific experiments or personal research equipment)
- Publication fees (e.g., open access journal charges)
- Printing and binding (thesis/dissertation, research posters)
- Membership dues for academic or scientific societies
- Professional development (e.g., workshops, certifications, or online courses)
- Library or lab access fees
- Visa application or renewal fees, or health insurance gaps (for international students)

How to Apply

Applications are reviewed quarterly. Students must provide a brief research summary, a statement of need, and documentation of the expense(s) for which they are seeking reimbursement. Applicants remain eligible for one year following submission.
